


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All grants need to match the MEDVIA strategy



Matching MEDVIA strategy

- Innovation involves cross over activities
- At least 2 out of 3 domains are involved
 - Biotechnology
 - Digital technology
 - Medical technology



MEDVIA consortium R&D/ feasibility



Research project

Activities aimed to build new knowledge, expertise and skills using a systematic approach.

Goal = to use the new knowledge to develop new products, processes or services or to significantly improve existing ones

Development project

Activities that use existing knowledge, expertise and skills.

Goal = to create plans, designs and prototypes of new, altered or improved products, processes and services

Feasibility study

Preparation of an ambitious fundable, innovative follow-up trajectory (within or outside VLAIO funding channels)

Not a small R or D project

MEDVIA consortium R&D/ feasibility

Eligibility for funding (*)

VLAIO criteria

- Funding limited to Flemish partners
- Research partners paid in full by others
- No OIM partners

MEDVIA criteria

- Min 3 companies (for/non-profit) of which
 2 in Flanders
- Min 1 MEDVIA member

VLAIO Funding for Flemish partners

• Companies: 25%..60% subsidy/partner

NOTE

- Feasibility studies and development project
 500 kEUR subsidy => no external experts
 used to evaluate (in general)
- Research project: max. 3 yrs, 100k€ 3M€
- Develop. project: max. 2 yrs, 25 k€ 3M€
- Feasibility project: max. 1 yr, 50k€/partner

MEDVIA cluster SBO (cSBO)



Specifics

- Independent, innovative research with the potential of economic or societal applications
- Goal: building new knowledge in order to start a dialogue between research centers and enterprises
- Projects that fit within the MEDVIA trajectory, results will contribute to the strategic roadmap of MEDVIA
- Need for a 'begeleidingscommissie' (advisory committee)



MEDVIA cluster SBO (cSBO)



Eligibility for funding (*)

VLAIO criteria

- At least 2 research groups of at least 1
 Flemish research institute
- Imec, VITO, VIB, Flanders Make, VLIZ, UC: in collaboration with at least 1 research institute
- Hospitals = companies

MEDVIA criteria

Min. 3 MEDVIA members in advisory committee

NOTE

- 4 yrs
- 100% subsidy
- Max. 500 k€/legal entity/year
- Max. 3M€
- Companies: subcontractor



MEDVIA consortium ICON

Eligibility for funding (*)

VLAIO criteria

- Min 3 industry partners
- Min 1 research partner
- Mandatory dissemination by research partner
- No OIM partners

MEDVIA criteria

- Min 3 companies (for/non profit) of which
 2 in Flanders
- Min 1 MEDVIA member

VLAIO Funding for Flemish partners

- Companies: 25%..60%
- Research partners: 100%

NOTE

- Independence of generic research!
- Need for advisory committee
- 2-4 yrs
- Max. 3M€ for company part
- Budget research partner: see cSBO

MEDVIA COOCK+



Specifics

- Translation and valorization of research results by accelerating the introduction of technology and/or knowledge to a large group of organisations
- Final results need to benefit (a specific part of) the MEDVIA ecosystem
- Part A: funded
- Part B: organization specific actions to evaluate knowledge, analyse, test
- Projects can still involve some research, but can not compromise dissemination

MEDVIA COOCK+



Eligibility for funding (*)

VLAIO criteria

- 1 or more organisations for research and knowledge
- Advisory committee (mostly SMEs) with minimum 5 Flemish organisations with strong involvement
- Part A (generic) / Part B (organization specific)

MEDVIA criteria

• Min. 3 MEDVIA members in advisory committee

VLAIO Funding for Flemish partners

- 50%-100% subsidy
- Company: subcontractor (specific expertise)
- 1-3 yrs
- Max. 1 MEUR



MEDVIA TETRA



Specifics

- Translation of recently available knowledge into concrete, useful information so that the target group can innovate faster and more efficiently
- Need for economic finality (to be translated into competitiveness, employment and investments in enterprises in Flanders). In addition, the project can address a societal challenge
- Fit with the educational assignment of the applicant(s).



MEDVIA TETRA



Eligibility for funding (*)

VLAIO criteria

- research group of a Flemish university college and/ or university which is actively engaged in practice-based research
- Advisory committee with strong involvement

MEDVIA criteria

- Min. 3 MEDVIA members in advisory committee
- Applicant is member of MEDVIA

VLAIO Funding for Flemish partners

- 2 yrs
- 92.5% subsidy
- Max. 480 K€

VLAIO funding



Schaalklaar

- Innovative start-ups (max. 5 years) with ambition and potential to scale on a short term. Subsidy supports the transition to scale-up
- Subsidy max. 350 kEUR (period of max. 3 years);
- Investment in production capacity which is needed for scaling
- Activities that are needed to comply with norms, labels, accreditations, registrations or other legal obligations.
- Investments in automatic processing and reporting of commercial, operational and financial data



VLAIO funding



KMO Groeisubsidie

- Flemish SME
- Themes: internationalisation, digitalisation, sustainable & circular entrepreneurship, innovation
- 3 calls in 2024
- External advice (EA) and/or recruitment of 1 strategic profile (RSP)
- Max. 50 kEUR (25 kEUR EA 25 kEUR RSP) subsidy



Flanders Investment & Trade



Starterspakket Internationalisering

- For Flemish SMEs who never received FIT funding
- Innovative companies that start exporting
- Possible activities: translation of website / inspiration journey
- Application with business plan and export plan with activities
- 9 kEUR

Support International entrepreneurship




